

NUMBER OF NGOS IN KAZAKHSTAN








GOVERNMENT SUPPORT TO THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL SECTOR IN THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN


- The state social contracting is one of the effective and classic mechanisms of interaction with NGOs (implemented since 2003)

- Awards for NGOs is one of the ways to motivate NGOs for their significant contribution to addressing social problems (introduced in 2017)








CURRENT SITUATION IN THE DYNAMICS OF THE STATE SOCIAL CONTRACTING


In 19 years, the total volume of SSC in Kazakhstan increased by 99%




Since the introduction of the state contracting:

- > more than **1,000 NGOs** are involved in the service provision;
- about 2,000 social projects in socially significant areas are implemented annually;
- > the number of people employed in the civil sector reached **37,000**;
- > the number of active NGOs increased to 17,000.





GRANT FINANCING



emphasis is placed <u>on transparency and efficiency in the</u> implementation of grant projects;


procedure for forming and maintaining <u>a roster of experts</u> and the openness of meetings of expert commissions are regulated;

<u>public discussion of grant topics</u> is conducted in order to determine the feasibility of future projects;

monitoring procedures with a mechanism for <u>evaluating</u> the effectiveness of grant projects were defined.


Dynamics of grant projects for 2016-2021

The number of NGO projects under grant financing increased **4.8 times**






INTRODUCTION OF GRANT FINANCING IN THE REGIONS OF THE COUNTRY



SOCIAL PROJECTS CASES



30 small grants were provided as part of the implementation of the "Birgemiz:Umit" volunteer project

- **14 public organizations** were created, which are engaged in search and rescue activities.
- **11 public organizations** conducted training and education on fire safety and first aid skills for victims
- 2 headquarters were established to improve and open new approaches to inform the population about the necessary actions to be taken in case of emergency situations and to promote knowledge about civil defense,
- 1 initiative group "112" was created,
- 1 volunteer group for assistance to animals in rural areas.

Results of small grants in the development of rural initiatives:

Fifteen different centers were created in rural areas, including a social workshop, centers for low-income and large families, a recreation center, a club for revival of national crafts, etc.

Five rooms were opened for the prevention of domestic violence and psychological and counseling support for women and for work with children with autism.

Thirteen playgrounds and sports facilities were built and equipped, including a sports gym for people with disabilities, senior citizens and others.

In eight areas they helped to solve environmental problems: 5 environmental events were held and a system of separate waste collection was introduced.

A gym and a sensory room were equipped for people with disabilities. **More than 80 people with disabilities were employed.** The first full-scale production of greenhouse frames suitable for the climate of the Republic of Kazakhstan was organized.

SOCIAL PROJECTS CASES



AWARDS FOR NGOs (2017 – 2021)

Over five years, 286 NGOs that have made a significant contribution to address socially significant issues have become the recipients of the Award. The minimum size of the prize is about \$12,000 (5 million tenge). The prizes are awarded in 15 areas.
